There are two single track motorcycle trails nearby at Porterfield (http://www.vvmapping.com/trails/porterfieldLake.html) and Bass Lake (http://www.vvmapping.com/trails/bassLake.html). There are also GPX files for dual sport and road rides based out of the campground available on the web (http://dco43054.com/phpbb/viewtopic.php?f=2&t=60&p=154#p154).

*** If you want to ride and do not have a GPS, do not worry! As is normal with these informal gatherings, people that choose to ride in the area will make it easy for those without a GPS to ride along. ***



Keep in mind that anyone riding the single track motorcycle trails will require both MI ORV stickers on their bike. Stickers can be purchased in advance on-line at http://www.michigan.gov/dnr/0%2C1607%2C7-153-10365 15070-168458-- %2C00.html .

MI also allows unlicensed motorcycles on many of their roads – but not the highway (95) that passes by the campground. This means that dirt bikes without a DOT license will have to be transported a short distance to an intersecting road where they are allowed. Dirt bikes that are not DOT licensed will require the MI ORV stickers to ride the trails and roads in the area.
